Prayer

What is prayer? What is the most effective way to pray? Is there more than one way to pray? Why does God answer prayer? How can I "know" that God has heard me? How much should I pray? How can I defend myself against evil prayers?

These are the questions that many of us have. If you've noticed, most people don't even bother to ask for prayer anymore. By many in the church, prayer is viewed as a "sympathy card" and a sort of "well wishing" for the afflicted. It is also commonly and aggressively used to let those who oppose you know your on the right track and you will "bring them around". This is **NOT** what Godly prayer is.

All prayer moves things in the spiritual realm. It will both bless and curse. Godly prayer gains you audience with your Heavenly Father; whereupon His angels are dispatched, mountains are moved, weapons formed against you are destroyed, demons flee, and even the dead come to life!

Evil prayer, also moves things in the spiritual realm and can even kill someone. Demons are dispatched, people are destroyed, sickness breaks forth and death is brought near.

Now, would you like someone who "knows" how to pray correctly, pray for you or would you like someone just shooting any and everything at you from the dark?

The fact that you would ask just anyone and everyone to pray for you and take no notice of the threats of others when they angrily insist they "WILL" pray for you is proof that people do not understand prayer and how it works. If they did and knew you knew how to pray they would flood you with non-stop prayer requests! Godly prayer is when you have a direct audience with God. How

effective do you think that would be?

What is prayer?

Prayer by theological definition means "incantation". It is a direct request to a divine being for assistance or to cause an effect you desire. Many religions pray to a diety, including wiccans. Some shaman even use the Lord's Prayer for protection. Why? Because there are spiritual laws in effect by which all prayers, both good and bad operate.

In truth you are casting a spell on someone when you pray. You are asking a divine being to do something on or for someone or to cause an effect in some way. There is no such thing as a "harmless" prayer or a prayer that "falls" to the ground. Here is a spiritual law for you to consider.

"Cast thy bread upon the waters: for thou shalt find it after many days" (Eccl. 11:1). This is a spiritual law. Here is the spiritual meaning of that phrase in regards to prayer.

What ever you send out on your knees will return to you in due time. Prayer is a two way carrier pigeon. Your bird will come home to roost. So you'd better make sure that what you pray for others you darn well want prayed or brought upon yourself, because you will "eat" of your own bread.

How NOT to Pray

Believe it or not, bad prayer **really** damages people! Yes, you can pray wrong and you can do someone great harm. Even prayers meant out of good intentions can be very damaging. Words that we speak have creative power. You can speak blessings or cursings upon others. You really should "ask" someone if you can pray for them before you do. To pray is to meddle in someone else's life. To do so mindlessly is

about the equivalent of playing with a loaded gun.

When someone gets angry with you or vice versa and they or you say, "I will pray for you." Let it be known that that person who said that is "threatening you". More than likely, that is a direct announcement that curses will be forthcoming and you'd best learn how to defend yourself, but more on that later.

Never pray from an angry, hurt, or resentful heart. If when you picture that person in your mind, you feel upset, you are spiritually and demonically tied into that person through this feeling. Your prayers will come from this source, which is demonic and could end up destroying both you and the one you are "praying" for. You must follow the Lord's Prayer first, before you ever pray for anyone. After your heart is right, then pray, I will cover that in depth in a moment.

So, you are **NOT** to pray for those whom you haven't forgiven. Anyone who makes you feel upset when you think of them is a red flare rising telling you that you have **NOT** forgiven them. Please read the booklet, "**How to Forgive**" for help, as you are in danger even as you read this if you haven't forgiven everyone in your life.

Never pray from negative thoughts and never pray evil over anyone. If you do, you are in truth casting evil spells on them and cursing them. These will return to you, and you will suffer badly.

How to Pray Correctly

Correct prayer comes from the Holy Spirit inside of you. You will pray from all that is good within you and many times by revelation. Here we will study the Lord's Prayer line by line, to see how you are to enter into prayer. Once you are coming from the "right" place within you, God will not deny your request! If you will notice it, the Lord's Prayer is an affirmation of spiritual laws and facts. Once you meet these laws and are in the "right" place, God moves in your behalf and in the behalf

of those you pray for. No wonder the disciples said in earnest, "teach us to pray!" I'm sure they heard request after request coming to pass and saw many mountains moved. Who wouldn't want that?! Here are the things you must know and do before you should ever begin prayer.

Principle #1: Our Father which art in heaven.

God isn't just your God, he is **The God** the **only** Father of us all. He is the only creator. He is in heaven, meaning His ways are higher than your ways and his thoughts than your thoughts.

Acknowledge the supremacy of His being. It means you are going to rely solely on Him as the source and supplier of the answer or solution.

Principle #2: Hallowed be thy name.

Respect. You fear and greatly respect Him. He is holy and without sin. This means you must have a deep and great respect for God.

Principle #3: Thy kingdom come.

This means that you are not trying to create "your" kingdom. You aren't praying to benefit yourself. You have buried your life in Christ and you are praying for His kingdom, the power of God, His government, His authority, and His throne to be established in whatever situation you are facing. You cannot carry a selfish intent in prayer to establish desires of your own or to try and make things happen in other peoples lives and your own like you think they should. God punishes people to make them repent. Giving everyone a million dollars might look good upfront, but what would it do to

the person who received it?

Principle #4: Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth.

Somehow I don't think you getting a nice car would be top priority in heaven. Or that someone who hurt your "feelings" should be punished just for you. God's will (desires and wishes) be done on earth as it is done in heaven. Well, what is done in heaven? Do you think demons are running around making people sick? Do you think evil is triumphant? What is God's will that is done in heaven? I'll tell you what it is, no evil is present there. No one is crying there. No one is sick there. No one is dying there. Not one person knows the pain of this world, the horrors of starvation or the ghastly sight of a rotten body. No little children go to bed hungry at night and cry for their mom or dad who had to put them in foster care or an orphanage just because they were too poor to feed them. No one is abducted and tortured to death and no babies are ripped from their mother's wombs in pieces. Can you pray down that line? Can you seek the healing and salvation of others? To intercede for a dying world? Can you pray that God's will be done here?

Principle #5: Give us day by day our daily bread.

No prayer request should ever be to fulfill our bodies lust. In a sort of, "wish list" mentality, though God may patiently humor you, it is most unwise. Your prayers must be for what you need only, but the

meaning of this goes even deeper. You are to ask for spiritual food. Your prayer life should include a request to God for the spiritual meaning of the word to feed you. You must look to Him to sustain you in and through prayer. You are to never try and reason out the scriptures through analysis and thinking, but to let understanding come to you while pondering upon His word. Let God be the One who sustains you, the one to turn the Light on in you.

Principle #6: And forgive us our debts: as we forgive our debtors.

If you pray for someone from an unrepentant angry heart you will only "curse" those you pray for. Before you pray you must forgive, "EVERYONE". In the book of Luke it actually says "everyone". If you don't forgive others, then you are no more than a witch. And your prayers are evil incantations to set demons to work.

Principle #7: And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever. Amen.

Here you are asking God, the Holy Spirit to protect and deliver you from evil. To give you the wisdom to stay above the muck of the world. Why? Because you **know** that His kingdom is the **ONLY** kingdom, and His power the **ONLY** power, and glory **BELONGS** to Him **FOREVER AND EVER!** And that is just the way it is.

Summing it up!

Before you drop down on your knees and cry out for help.....you must understand.....

1. God is your only answer! You will rely solely on Him to solve the problem or "fix" things.
2. He is Holy and to be feared. Do not take this lightly. You pray respectfully.
3. You don't have selfish motives. Your prayer is not based upon you and your plans or desires.
4. Your requests are genuine and coming from a good place in your heart.
5. You are seeking God's hand and relying on Him as your spiritual and physical sustenance.
6. You are patient, and overlooking and kind to everyone from now on and know that you are forgiven.
7. You are depending on God alone, to deliver you from evil, you do not strike when struck.

- 1. You serve only Him**
- 2. You honor His name alone**
- 3. Your faith is in Him alone**
- 4. You seek to do His will**
- 5. Your motives are right**
- 6. You have forgiven everyone**
- 7. You are depending on Him alone**

If you can get these principles in your heart then by all means **GET ON YOUR KNEES!** Your prayers will move the mountains. Why? Because it is God all the way! The incantation you will speak will blow away the demonic realm and the angels will come by the droves to carry out God's words spoken through your mouth. No enemy will be able to withstand you as you pour forth the spiritual meaning of the word and break the necks of every demonic creature that dares to step across

your path, because it is God in you that is working and doing.

Essentials of Prayer

Once you have aligned with these basic spiritual laws the Lord's prayer there are a few more basic principles to keep in mind.

First, That God can do anything! His power and His wisdom and ways are UNLIMITED! All good things come from Him and He is not limited in what or what measure He can give. You have not because you ask not (James 4:3).

Second, You always ask the Father in Jesus name. For it is only by the name of Jesus that we are able to come to the Father. Always end you prayers with "I pray or ask in Jesus name" (John 14:13).

Third, prayers made in secret will be rewarded openly, meaning that you are praying to be seen and heard by God alone....no one else. It doesn't matter who else hears what you have to say, they aren't the ones sending you the answer, God is. You also aren't going to be heard because you are noisy or keep repeating yourself either. (Matt. 6:6).

Vital Information

How witches cast spells and how voodoo curses are brought forth:

This is a very brief description, but to draw evil spirits to you, you must become

very angry. Anger will draw the demons to you as will other sins. The angrier you get, the stronger the demon you will attract. If doing voodoo, then once you've accumulated as much "negative" energy as you can, you shove a needle into the place you wish to hurt on the other person through mental imagery. If casting an incantation speak the anger into the words you use when cursing.

How cords are tied into you:

Cords is a word which means you are "connected" spiritually to someone or something. When a smart witch curses you, he or she will quickly try and "let go" of the anger once the demon is sent. Why? They don't want them returning. What do you think happens when you are mad at someone, speaking evil of them, and won't forgive? Then imagine that that person is doing the same thing back towards you? How many demons are the two of you collecting and e-mailing back and forth through your cord!?

How to break a cord?

The moment you truly forgive someone, the cord is broken. You can also break them in the name of Jesus, but if you haven't forgiven that person, you will not sever it. Once the cord is broken the person sending the demons gets all the demons back. If you were the sender, then the sending will cease once you truly forgive that person. This is just and fair and how God made it. If you play with fire, you will get burnt.

If you tie a wicked cord into an innocent person your wicked cord will return some 10 some 100 fold! So be careful to forgive quickly. Now, just imagine you are harboring evil thoughts about God. Blaming Him for something. The outcome of this will not be good. Most likely resulting in illness or death. The wrath of God is reserved for such people.

Casting your bread on the water. The water is the cord. Casting is the prayer. In due time it will return. If you are sending out good cords, then you have much to smile about, because look what will come back on your cord! The blessings of God. The bible refers to the silver cord of life. When you think of someone, you have located that silver cord. This is how smart demons travel.

What do you think would happen if you thought evil angry thoughts of someone all day long? How do you think this would affect the "silver cord". Did you know in a laboratory test living cells were put into two sealed containers. In one container, people just projected horrible evil thoughts at it and to the other people thought good thought towards it. The one which had projected thoughts of evil upon it died....all the cells died!

Now, what do you think might happen if you do that to yourself or someone else? Have you ever met people who had nothing good to say about themselves or anyone else? There are many church goers who could shame a right nasty witch with their spells called "concerned prayers" and the gossip and slander chains are famous in churches and are nothing more then demonic incantations, curses, and spells. Words of demons coming forth from your mouth to bring about their evil desires. How clever of them, and stupid of anyone who participates! For when the curses come home to roost, sickness will abound.

How to pray without ceasing?

Paul commanded us to "pray without ceasing". But just how does one do that? Surely one has to eat, sleep, and do other things! Yet it is done by us all the time and I will show you how. You can pray either good or evil without ceasing and you do it all the time. When you rehearse a "feeling" in your mind over and over again

you are praying for someone. You are generating either a positive or a negative response towards that person.

When you are angry with someone or have a problem and you try and find a way to excuse your own anger or to fix it you rehearse the scene over and over in your mind. Each time the emotions build, resentment rises, and you find yourself venting these feelings of frustration to others, (speaking evil). Then you feel guilty for speaking evil of them and try and justify what you just said and are angry that you feel guilty. Some people will pretend they are giving information so others will help them or pray for them. Sometimes it is true, they really are stumped by the situation, other times the truth of the matter is they know they are wrong and they just want someone else to agree with them in an attempt to ease their own guilt.

If you truly overlook another's fault, you see it, but you don't let it bother you, then you won't be praying evil towards those persons. Your thoughts will be good and kind and your prayers helpful and very beneficial. But if your thoughts are not good, and you are praying from pride or anger etc., you will not help that person and you will harm yourself in the process.

Praying in tongues.....

The purpose of tongues is for the edification of your spirit man and others. This type of prayer is extremely beneficial. I recommend praying at least 1 hour a day but certainly as much as you can. This is God praying His perfect will into your life! It is crucial! You will begin to develop the mind of Christ and pray the perfect prayers. Groanings will come forth, you will hear conversations and pleadings taking place, intercessions, warfare, praise, songs, and more. Praying in tongues is crucial to your spiritual growth. If you do not have this gift read booklet "How to speak in

tongues" for more help.

Praying in your sleep.....

Believe it or not, I have had this happen to me. I have awoken and heard my "spirit man" praying. Are we still sending positive and negative feelings while asleep? It is highly possible.

Prayer through meditation.....

I prefer a quiet meditative state for prayer. This is how I sit in God's presence and reflect. It allows me to see more clearly that which He wishes me to pray for and to not get entangled in unwanted thoughts. Others prefer to shout it out from the roof tops. You must find your own way and there are times for all ways.

Power of prayer

1 John 5:16 If any man see his brother sin a sin which is not unto death, he shall ask, and he shall give him life for them that sin not unto death. Ther is a sin unto death: I do not say that he shall pray for it.

This kind of prayer is for a christian brother or sister. This is the power of prayer. You have the ability to speak an incantation that will send enough reinforcements to your brother or sister that life will be given to that person. This prayer needs to come forth from the Holy Spirit's unction. If you were to pray it out of pride, it would not work. It must come forth from a humble heart that is

doing the work of God.

James 5:16

Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

You want help? Have a problem you can't seem to get over? Do you want healing? Then you need to pay attention to what I'm about to reveal to you. A self-righteous prideful person could not confess his faults, could he? How many people could you confess your faults to that wouldn't rejoice over the fact that you had them? This is how far the family of God has fallen.

The way the body of Christ is supposed to work is that you should be able to confess your faults and others are truly saddened by what they hear. Then, you begin to pray and intercede for each others weaknesses. Once prayer commences and all the people are genuinely praying for each other, healing comes. This will only work if every one involved is truly righteous, not self-righteous. A righteous person is one who is humble and knows that his only good is God in him.

James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord: And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

Who are the "elders" of the church? They are supposed to be the Christians who are the most sanctified and have the best understanding of God, the Truth, in them. Why is this a necessity? Because if you pray from an evil source the poor

sick guy is going to really be in trouble! In reality you are saying, "have the person who stands the least chance of cursing through incantations step forward and pray please?!"

Anointing oil is to show that the Holy Spirit is doing the healing. You pray or speak your commands and incantations in the name of the Lord, for it is by His authority that demons flee. If that person has listened to the demon and sinned, it will be forgiven him.

The prayer of faith is different than an asking. You are speaking things into existence. The parameters of this is huge and without limitations.

Closing

In closing, the prayer of faith moves the mountains. However, does God answer the prayers of demons who speak through your mouth? This is why you must follow the Lord's prayer. If your heart isn't right with God, why should he listened to you more or rather than a demon?

Faith comes from knowing God as is an attribute of God. To pray from faith you are praying from God within you. (see booklet "how to live from divine inspiration). It is out of this source, God in you, that all answerable prayers will come forth. Jesus lives to make intercession for us, the Spirit of Christ, the Holy Spirit is within us crying out, "Abba Father". It is His intercession, requests brought forth through us to the Father in His name that come to pass.

We need only to heed His holy divine presence to pray the prayers of faith and the prayers which will not be denied. The Lord's Prayer, really is the Lord's Spirit praying through us to the Father in constant intercession for us. Thank you Jesus!
